

SUMMARY DESCRIPTION AND COST ESTIMATE OF PRESENT NOTIFICATION

A. GENERAL

NSPA has been designated as Host Nation, for the acquisition of CP project 5A0156 "Provide NATO with Equipment for Deployable HQ" serial 5HQ27010-01 "Provision of vehicle and personnel utility crossings".

Due to the specificity of the requirement, one Invitation for Bids (IFB) will be issued:

1. Vehicle Cable Ramps/Protectors;
2. Pedestrian Cable Ramps/Protectors.

The following information contains excerpts from the Statements of Work that will be released during the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) process.

B. Project Objectives

The Contractor shall furnish NSPA with the following equipment:

Vehicle and Pedestrian Cable Ramps/Protectors for:

- Four 500 man Large Headquarters Camps (each having two vehicle crossing points and six pedestrian crossings);
- Two 15 man Remote Site Camps (each having two vehicle crossing points and four pedestrian crossings).

Sizes of cable used in camps: Various from \varnothing 19mm to \varnothing 50mm power cables
Up to 20 mm fibre optic cable.

Equipment to be provided in accordance with detailed technical requirements defined in applicable Statements of Work (SOW). These assets will be used to provide NATO Deployable camps with the capability of driving vehicles within the camp area where cables and water hoses exist. The equipment shall be used over a wide range of geographic environments and climatic conditions with operating temperatures ranging between -32°C and +49°C. Accordingly, NATO expects the equipment to be robust and of high quality, as per the specification of the SOW.

C. Logistic Support Elements

High quality documentation for spares, assembly and maintenance is required, as per the specification of the SOW.

D. SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a. DELIVERY
No more than 9 months after contract award.
- b. PARTIAL BIDDING
No partial offers will be entertained.
- c. REQUIREMENTS IN OPTION
Requests for requirements in OPTION (additional quantities) will be included.
- d. QUALITY ASSURANCE
Requirement for ISO 9001:2015 and AQAP 2130 Quality Assurance are included.
- e. SECURITY LEVEL REQUIRED
NATO UNCLASSIFIED
- f. LANGUAGE
1) "*Cahier des Charges*" and subsequent procurement contracts will be in English language.
2) Offers and any communication to be made by the Bidders, and any technical data or documentation to be furnished by the Contractors must be also in English.
- g. CURRENCY CONVERSION RATES
N/A at this stage.

D. FINAL CONSIDERATIONS

- a. NSPA intends to issue the IFB to interested firms at a date yet to be determined, but not before the **30th of June 2017**. The Bidders will be allowed not less than 42 calendar days to reply to the relevant IFB.
- b. The bids to be received in response to the NSPA IFB mentioned above will be valid for a period of 180 calendar days.
- c. The envisioned bidding method is the "One Step International Competitive Bidding Procedure".
- d. The information to be provided to the Bidders will be up to NATO UNCLASSIFIED.
- e. Please note that actual quantities to be included in the IFB may vary slightly from those specified in this NOI. Some project deliverables may be included in IFB as options to be acquired at later stages of the project implementation process.
- f. **ESTIMATED VALUE FOR ICB CONTRACTS: 154,000.00 EURO**
