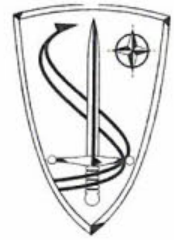


Subject: Notification of Intent (NOI) to Issue an Invitation for International Bidding (IFIB) for Maintenance services and intervening repairs on an as needed basis on the fire alarm panel system, the intrusion detection-, CCTV-, tannoy-, entry and escape door control unit system in Buildings 312, 313 and 314 at HQ AIRCOM located on U.S. Air Base in 66877 Ramstein-Miesenbach in Germany.
