Subject: **Notification of Intent** (NOI) to issue an Invitation For International Bidding (IFIB) for the supply of NATO medals.

1. In accordance with the stipulations of the Bi-SC Procurement Directive 60-70, Annex B, the following information is provided on an Invitation For International Bidding (IFIB) that this Headquarters has the intention to release.

IFIB Reference : ACO-SH-18-01

Title of IFIB : Supply of NATO medals

Requirement : Supply of (a) NATO medals for current/future operations (such as RSM, KFOR, etc.) (b) NATO Meritorious Service Medals and (c) medals for EU current/future operations (such as ALTHEA, etc.). Other ancillary items may be required such as certificates, uniform patches, etc.

Type of contract : Firm, Fixed Price (FFP), Requirement-type contract

Period of performance : One base year (2019) + up to four one-year options

Bidding procedure : Lowest compliant bid. The solicitation will be posted on the ACO Electronic Bidding Portal (www.ebidexchange.com/aco). Firms interested to participate are invited to apply for registration on the portal

Funding : Military Budget (JFC Brunssum, JFC Naples, others). Estimated yearly amount: 200 KEURO. Estimated total cumulative value of the contract: 1 MEURO (subject to actual requirements)

Issue Date : April 2018, planned

Bid Closing Date : June 2018, planned

Classification of IFIB : NATO UNCLASSIFIED

Eligibility : Governmental or Commercial entities (1) that originate and are chartered/incorporated within NATO-member nations, (2) that maintain a professionally active facility (office, factory, laboratory, etc.) within NATO-member nations and (3) that provide the funding for the aforementioned requirement. Vendors shall have successfully performed at least 3 (three) contracts within the last 5 (five) years substantially similar in scope, complexity and magnitude to the requirement described in the SHAPE solicitation.


